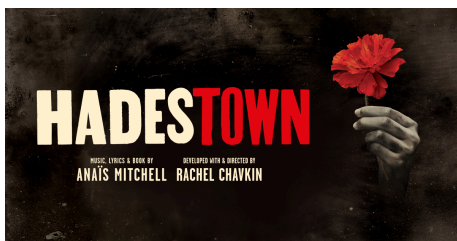
Bronze DofE Expedition

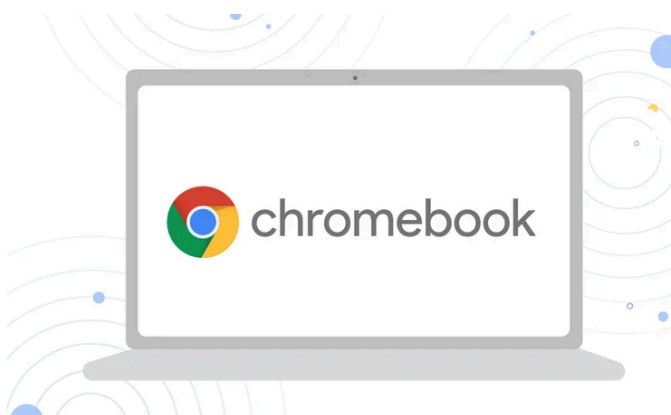
