Year 13 Geography Trips

Sixth Form Geography Trip to Stratford, London

On Monday, Year 13 our Geography students visited Stratford, London as part of their urban fieldwork studies. The trip provided an excellent opportunity geographical explore kev includina regeneration, land use patterns, and the legacy of the London 2012 Olympic games. Students collected data through field sketches, environmental quality surveys, pedestrian counts and land use mapping. The visit not only enhanced their understanding of regeneration but also gave them valuable experience in conducting real-world research which will now form a crucial part of their coursework.



Sixth Form Geography Trip to Isle of Sheppey

Then on Tuesday, our Year 13 Geography students visited Warden Bay and Minster-on-sea, Kent, as part of their coastal fieldwork studies. The trip provided an excellent opportunity to explore key geographical themes, including erosion, deposition and coastal management . Students collected through data sketches, groyne measurements, longshore drift tests and beach profiles. The visit not enhanced their understanding of coastal processes but also gave experience valuable conducting real-world research which will now form a crucial part of their coursework.
